## **FOOD SERVICE WORKER**

Under general supervision perform a variety of tasks involved in the serving of food in a facility, including cleaning and maintaining of kitchen utensils, equipment, and work areas. Perform additional related duties as required.

A food service worker may have combined duties or specific, such as dishwashing only.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

- One year of experience in food set-up, service, and clean-up, or equivalent combination of training, education, and experience.
- Knowledge of standard units of measure and weight for liquid and solid food to portion out required quantities -- basic level of math ability.
- Understanding of basic practices for safe food storage and prevention of contamination and of safe work practices in a kitchen.
- Basic knowledge of kitchen and floor cleaning and of sanitizing and proper usage of products.
- Ability to use kitchen serving utensils and operate hot food warmer, storage equipment and dishwashing equipment.
- Ability to use kitchen and floor cleaners and cleaning implements.
- Ability to read and understand security procedures and mixing instructions for cleaners.
- Ability to write legible requests for repairs or supplies.
- Ability to follow and give oral directions.
- Ability to maintain on time regular attendance practices.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers.
